

Bixby is in the Lights of December Parade this Saturday, December 1st! **Please sign up on the BCB board** if you want to march in the parade with us- only the first 50 can march! Parents-please consider pairing up with other families so more children may attend. Anyone who cannot march, may watch the parade from the crowd which is fun in a different way- you actually get to see the whole parade!

We'll have **hot chocolate and cider** for all community members who join us to march in or watch the parade. Please be at our staging spot **NO LATER THAN 5:40pm with your lantern!** The parade begins at 6:00pm sharp!

Bixby is **Number 32** in the parade (see the staging map below)- meet at the SW corner of Spruce and 16th street.

Parade Reminders: 5th graders have first rights to carry the Bixby banner at the front of our entry. Keep up with the people in front of you and with the entry in front of us- parade organizers are very firm on this point. No dressing up as Santa. Complete parade rules are posted on the BCB board in the gym.

Wear your Bixby gear- scarves and hats from past parades or sweatshirts, etc from the Bixby store! Most importantly- join us and have FUN!

Parade Parking:

Please carpool. Parking in all City of Boulder parking structures (look for the green P) is **FREE** on the night of the parade. While parking IS free in the City garages, you must keep your parking ticket in order to exit the garage when you leave. There is a \$50 fee for lost tickets – so leave that ticket somewhere in your car so you don't lose it!

Parade night is also a great night to HOP, SKIP or JUMP downtown. As downtown is the major hub for RTD bus routes you can get downtown by bus from just about anywhere in Boulder.
